♦ **Father's Day** – Next Sunday is Father's Day. Fathers will be leading the service and Carl Shinn will be preaching the Father's Day message.

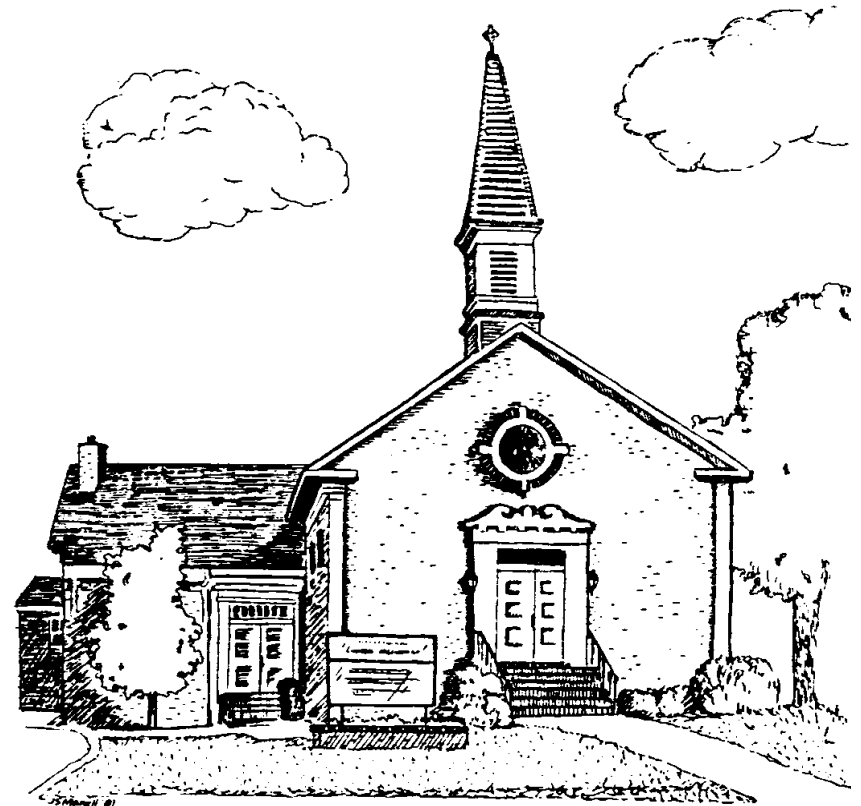
